


How to Report Lateral Flow Test Results



Lateral Flow Testing

The following slides are a guide to reporting your Lateral Flow Test Results via the government portal. It is important that you report every test result.

If you do not have an account, please continue to the next slide and follow our guide on how to create an account.

If you already have an account, please go to slide 12 for a guide on how to report your results.

Creating an account is encouraged as it will save you time when reporting future results.

Please scan the QR code on your Lateral Flow Test Kit. This will take you to the Government website.

Creating an Account

When you reach the Gov.uk website, select start now. You will then be greeted by the below. Please select sign in or create an account. Creating an account may take time to set up however will save you time when reporting future results.

Would you like to sign in or create an account to save your details?



Sign in or create an account

Creating an account takes 2 minutes. You can add all household members and save 5 minutes when reporting each result.



Continue without an account

Your details won't be saved for future tests and all information will have to be re-entered.

Creating an Account

After selecting “sign in or create an account” you will be directed to the NHS login service. Please enter your email address, you can use your personal or NHS email. A copy of your test results will be sent to this email address.

If you have not signed up before, you will be prompted to set up a new NHS login and asked to create a password.

Select **Continue** to set up a new NHS login with and register with **Covid 19 Digital testing service**.

Creating an Account

After creating an account, you will be sent a 6 digit security code to your email address. Please use this code to verify your email address.

Then, you will be asked for a mobile number, whenever you report a result you will be sent a confirmation text to this number. You will then be sent a 6 digit security code via text, please use this code to verify your mobile number.

Creating an Account

Next, you will need to agree to the NHS login terms and conditions.

You will then be directed back to the Government website and see the following page.

Creating an Account

You will then be asked for some personal details and why you took the test. Please give all the necessary information and follow the onscreen instructions.

This information will be saved to your account so you will not need to re-enter it when reporting future results.

Reporting Your Result

After entering the required information you will be asked about your Lateral Flow test. You will need to enter the date you undertook the test and need to enter the test strip ID number.

If you are using a mobile device you can Scan the QR code on the test strip to save time.

Both the test strip ID and QR code are located at the top of the Lateral Flow Test.

What's the test strip ID number?

This is printed on the test strip (next to the QR code).

Reporting Your Result

After entering the test strip ID you will be need to enter some personal details, you will not need to enter these details when reporting future results. You will then be asked to check your answers and confirm your details are correct.

Finally, please provide the result of your Lateral Flow Test.

Reporting Your Result

The following slides are a guide to reporting results when you have an existing account.

First, navigate to the Government website to report your result. This can be found by either scanning the QR code on your Lateral Flow Test Kit or navigating to the below link.

Reporting Your Result

Once you reach the Gov.uk website, please select start now and log in to your account. You will be directed to the NHS Login service. If you do not have an account please go to slide 4 for a guide on how to do this, having an account will save you time when reporting future results.

After logging in you will be asked who you are reporting a result for, below the "myself" option will be your DOB to confirm the details are yours.

Who are you reporting a result for?

Reporting Your Result

Next, you will be asked if the test was for your job and asked about your work. These options will be pre-selected from when you signed up for an account. Check the correct options have been selected and follow the onscreen instructions.

You will then be asked when the test was taken. Please report your result as soon as possible after the test is taken, no later than 24 hours.

When was the test taken?

Report a result as soon as possible on the day the test is taken (and no later than 24 hours).

Select a date

- Today, 06 August 2021
- Yesterday, 05 August 2021

Reporting Your Result

You will then be taken to the below screen, please enter your test strip ID number, this can be found at the top of your Lateral Flow Test. Or, if you are using a mobile device you can scan the QR code at the top of the Lateral Flow Test.

What's the test strip ID number?

This is printed on the test strip (next to the QR code).

After entering the test strip ID / QR code follow the onscreen steps which will then take you to review your person details which were entered when you created an account.

After doing this, you will see the below screen. Please enter your test result.
